ORDINANCE NO. 72

Series of 2011

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 286, SERIES OF 1998, ENTITLED -
"ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLASSIFICATION OF BUSINESSES
OPERATING IN THE CITY OF MARIKINA THAT ARE SUBJECT TO ISSUANCE
OF BARANGAY CLEARANCE AND PRESCRIBING THE RATES OF PAYMENT
TO BE IMPOSED THEREON"

WHEREAS, Section 458 Paragraph (2) (ii) states that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall:

“(ii) Subject to the provisions of Book II of this Code and applicable laws and upon the majority vote of all the members of the sangguniang panlungsod, enact ordinances levying taxes, fees and charges, prescribing the rates thereof for general and specific purposes, and granting tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs; x x x”

WHEREAS, on December 2, 1998, the City Council of Marikina passed an Ordinance which classified the businesses operating in the city that are subject to the issuance of barangay clearance and prescribe the rates of payment to be imposed in each classification;

WHEREAS, considering the length of time since the passage of the said ordinance and how the economy has changed, this City Council deemed it necessary to adjust reasonably the rates of barangay clearance fees;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the CITY COUNCIL of MARIKINA, in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 286, Series of 1998 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 1. Business operating in the City of Marikina that are subject to Barangay Clearance are hereby categorized and classified, as follows:

- (a) CLASS “AA” business, include big factories, industrial and manufacturing plants, private markets, malls, hotels
- (b) CLASS “A” business, include hospitals, fast-food chains, banks, drugstores with groceries, gasoline stations, telecommunication facilities/projects (PLDT, GLOBE, CABLE projects), apartments or lot for lease with monthly income above Php 30,000.00
- (c) CLASS “B” business, include groceries, lumber hardware stores, drugstores, pawnshops, garment makers, industrial shops with not less than 50 workers, computer shops with more than 20 computer units, apartments or lot for lease with monthly income of Php 20,000.00 – Php 30,000.00
- (d) CLASS “C” business, include shoe shops, welding shops, mechanical/electrical shops, auto repair shops, machine shops, junk shops, vulcanizing shops, restaurants/canteens, video rental outlets, beauty parlors, garment shops, car washers, bakeries, construction offices, trucking services, all other businesses with more than three (3) personnel, general merchandise, dental, medical, lying-in clinics, videoke/karaoke bars, beerhouses, pre-schools, “techon /manok” stalls, furniture shops and stores, “talipapas” or small private market, meat/chicken/fish vendors, rice retailer, (20 stalled vegetable vendors, fruit stands, including stalls for rent with a monthly income not less than Php 10,000.00, computer shops with less than 20 computer units, big junkshops, apartments or lot for lease with monthly income below Php 20,000.00

- (e) CLASS "D" business, include sari-sari store(s), eateries, rooms single stalls, two (2) man bakery stalls, puto/bibingka / sweets/ sago/ gulaman/ barbeque/banana-Q/ vendors with stalls, tailoring shops, dress shops, meat/chicken/vegetable/fruit vendor, stallholder in "talipapas" or private markets, two man vulcanizing shops, small junkshops

SECTION 2. Section 2 of the same Ordinance is likewise amended as follows:

"SECTION 2. Fees.


The following barangay clearance fees are hereby imposed on the above-mentioned businesses as classified, to be collected by the respective barangays:

- a. CLASS "AA" – Three Thousand Pesos (Php 3,000.00)
- b. CLASS "A" – Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00)
- c. CLASS "B" – One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00)
- d. CLASS "C" – Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00)
- e. CLASS "D" – Three Hundred Pesos (Php 300.00)
- f. CLASS "E" – One Hundred Pesos (Php 100.00)

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
